Mice

Rats

- Seal cracks and holes on your exterior. Mice can slip through an opening as small as a dime.

- Don't allow moisture to build up under appliances or in crawl spaces and basements.
- Keep trees and shrubs trimmed clear of the house.
- Cover chimneys with mesh or caps.
